Public Participation at Meetings

Persons wishing to address topics on the agenda may do so following introduction of the item by the chairman and prior to committee discussion. Comments shall be limited to three minutes per person. The time may be extended by a majority vote of the committee members present.

In the event there is a topic of interest to many persons or if the committee wishes to solicit public comment on a particular issue a separate meeting or public forum may be scheduled. Rules of the meeting or forum will be discussed by the committee and published prior to the meeting or forum.

Decorum

Persons present shall not applaud or otherwise express approval or disapproval of any statements made or actions taken at such meeting. Expressions of approval or disapproval may be intimidating to others who wish to speak.
