Policy JJI was last reviewed in 2007. The Committee discussed this policy and its purpose at length. Statements of philosophy in the policy manual serve the School Board during decision-making. The policy was changed to address all extra-curricular activities, including athletics. The belief statements have been removed from the policy and will be placed in extra-curricular notification documents. Additional language has been added to bring clarity to the intent and purpose of extracurricular activities at each level. The Committee recommends including JJI-R in the Policy Manual, as it provides clear guidance on the administrative structure and athletic teams organization. The committee will continue discussion of the policy and make final recommendations.

- [EEA](#) - Student Transportation Services

Policy EEA was last reviewed in 2013. In the Fall, community members from the Brentwood neighborhood approached the Board requesting it reconsider the walk-to-school zone for Pond Cove students. Monica Cooke, Director of Transportation, and Jay Madden, Transportation Coordinator, provided the committee with information regarding the current walk zone, numbers of Pond Cove students in the walk zone, and the potential impact of changes to the walk zone. Members discussed the safety challenges for students in the Brentwood neighborhood on the south side of Scott Dyer Road. There is no crossing guide and securing a guide has been very difficult. It was determined that the current policy addresses this need for exception under C. Hazardous Walking Conditions. Additional language was developed to provide an example of hazardous conditions that addresses the presenting need. First reading of Policy EEA took place at the February 11th School Board meeting. No comments have been received.

- [JICIA](#) - Weapons, Violence and School Safety

Policy JICIA was last reviewed in 2013. Recommended changes align language to the statute and provide greater clarity. First reading of Policy JICIA took place at the February 11th School Board meeting. No comments have been received.

- [BEDF](#) - Voting Methods and Quorums

Policy BEDF was last reviewed in 2013. Language was added to address the Board's obligation to open public voting. First reading of Policy BEDF took place at the February 11th School Board meeting. No comments have been received.

- [KCD](#) - Public Gifts/Donations to the School

Policy KCD was last reviewed in 2016. The Business Manager is recommending an adjustment to the gift value that requires School Board approval for acceptance. In order to bring alignment between policies, the Committee will revisit the threshold amount of a donation needing Board approval. The Committee will continue the discussion regarding gifts/donations and ethics.
